PFRPA Dental Plan ** MAJOR ENHANCEMENTS MADE **

PFRPA is pleased to announce major enhancements to the PFRPA Dental Plan! Effective June 1, 2018: 1) The annual maximum increased to \$3,000; 2) Retired NFL players can add their lawful spouse to share their dental plan coverage; 3) All enrolled retired players now have the same coverage, regardless of total credited seasons earned. To add your spouse to your coverage, you must complete an Affidavit for Spousal Eligibility. Download an Affidavit by clicking or entering the following link into your browser: goo.gl/YPb8hc. Please note that you do not need a new ID card, as your current ID card is valid for both you and your spouse.

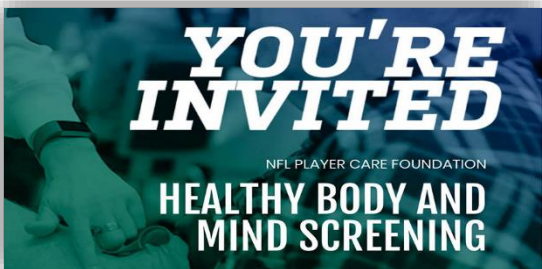
The Football Players Health Study at Harvard University
